went to an exhibition by a Belgian sculptor called Peter Buggenhout vesterday, which I I found very unusual. The show is on at the Maskara gallery in Colaba, which is like a warehouse with 40 ft high ceilings. I think it is a perfect setting for work of this nature. Buggenhout's work is very modern and unusual. The sculptures look like they are made out of debris at a glance, but closer inspection reveals bizarre use of materials, which includes dust, body hair, blood and human body parts! The show is curiously titled The Blind Leading The Blind and the artist claims his work is completely abstract and does not include the least bit of symbolism!
