There is an entire series of domestic objects wrapped in red wool in your current show.

Yes, ever since I started living between India and Holland, I discovered that there are a lot of objects that I barely use anymore. In a sense I am attempting to trap the history, to wrap the time I spent with them. I have even managed to wrap two decommissioned answering machines with red wool. In transforming them, the time I spent with them is trapped.



The image of you lying down on a heap of soil is singularly disturbing.

Strange that you say that. To me, it is rather soothing. Terra is me suspended between two heaps of soil, at the head and at the foot. Since I have been playing with the migration of objects for a while, this seems an appropriate performance

art piece. I carry the soil with m and it becomes part of my physi cality, my movement. My position keeps changing in the world, and it attaching sometimes as firm as soi (the earth) to this movement, bring attention to how th ephemeral is entrenched in ou lives, the time we spend here.

The photograph of you atop a de crepit truck. What's that about? It's part of a prison in Turkey wher they host an art show each year. am standing atop an object tha you would expect to move, but i won't, being inside a prison com pound. So while I, draped in a sar am seen from a lower perspectiv (almost like a prisoner would see out the sky), there is yet anothe contrast aside from that of motion I have a perspective that is invisible to the viewer, I am looking beyone the prison wall but the viewer can not see this perspective.

So you pretty much use any plac and create a moment out of it. Yes, these works are testimony to how time can be trapped despit the fleeting moment.

What is your performance her going to be about?

Only time will tell. To give you gist, it is my reaction to the Nov 2 terror attacks in Mumbai.
